TUITION PAYMENT PLAN DETAILS:

**PLAN A: DEADLINE 09/4/23 STANDARD TUITION WITH REGISTRATION FEE BEING ONLY \$8.00
BETTER SAVINGS**

Register and submit first month's (September) standard tuition payment, postmarked before 09/4/2023 with a discounted registration fee of \$8.00. Monthly standard tuition payments continue with payment due the first week of every month.

PLAN B: STANDARD TUITION AND REGISTRATION FEE

Register and submit standard tuition payment and \$15.00 registration fee. When registering in the middle of the month, multiply the remaining weeks in the month by \$15.00 plus the registration fee. Following months will be due the first week of each month at standard tuition payment.

PLAN C: PRE-PAID YEARLY PAYMENT SAVE 5% ON STANDARD TUITION

Register and submit tuition payment for the year and save 5%. Payment must be made in full to receive a 5% discount. DEADLINES STATED ABOVE APPLY TO YEARLY PREPAYMENT. No yearly refunds will be issued after 12/29/23. Refunds prior to 12/29/23 will be charged a \$20.00 service fee.

PAYMENT POLICY (strictly enforced)

- Tuition due by the 8th of each month. A drop box is located in the lobby on the front desk for any payments, if no one should be at the front desk.
- Payment received between the 9th to the 17th of the month subject to \$10.00 late fee.
- Payment received between the 18th to the 30th of the month subject to \$15.00 late fee.
- Accounts 31 days past due: Class instruction will discontinue and subject to legal collection and all legal fees.
- Returned check fee: \$30.00
- Tuition is monthly and will NOT be prorated for any reason.
- All debts must be paid for in full by May 31, 2024 in order to participate in the 2023 annual dance recital.
- Refunds will be given if PAC-LV is responsible for cancellations or changes.

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GENERAL RULES, RECITAL INFORMATION AND PICTURE INFORMATION

ATTENDANCE: It is very important that each student attends every class during the year. If a class is missed due to illness or canceled due to weather conditions or a holiday, you have the option of making the class up, within one month in a similar class. Tuition will not be prorated for any reason. The studio is closed for the following holidays: Thanksgiving (11/20-11/26); Christmas (12/23-1/2); Easter(3/29-3/31); Memorial Day(5/25-5/27). During bad weather conditions, please check Channel 69 News. We do not follow any school district closings for snow. If a quarantine should happen in the future classes will resume on Zoom, tuition as stated in the registration packet will be due by the 8th of the month.

GENERAL ATTIRE/RULES: No dangle earrings/jewelry. No hard candy or chewing gum. No cell phones in class. All students are required to wear dance clothes. Any color leotard, tights, shorts, skirts, or leggings are allowed, except for Ballet 1, Ballet 2, and Ballet 3. **School clothing, pajama pants and jeans of any kind are not permitted!** I suggest that you **check out our Revolution Dance Wear, where students receive a discount** on all dance shoes. Never wear dance shoes outside!

RECITAL AND PICTURE INFORMATION:

RECITAL: A dance recital will be held for dance classes, at the end of the season late May or early June. Costumes will be worn for the recital. Costume deposits can be handed in starting in September. A minimum deposit of \$25.00 will be due by September 29, 2023. A second minimum deposit of \$25.00 will be due by October 27, 2023. Final payment for recital costumes will be due November 17, 2023. Deposits are not mandatory, but highly recommended. Combo classes and Pre-K will be participating in the recital with 2 dances. Recital participation is optional. The recital will be held at a local auditorium. Students will receive an award for their hard work and dedication. Along with the recital there will be a mandatory rehearsal for the recital on recital day at the local auditorium. All students participating in the recital are required to stay until the end of the recital. Tutu Cute class will not participate in the recital.

PICTURES: Pictures are held in April of the dance season at the studio. You will be notified ASAP of a confirmed date. Solo pictures are optional; group pictures are mandatory.

DANCE CLASS SCHEDULE: All times and days are subject to change pending class sizes. You will be notified if your selected class has changed or is canceled. 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BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF VARIOUS CLASSES

Listed Alphabetically

Afro Jazz: African Jazz or Afro Jazz blends together many styles of dance, including Caribbean, African, swing, and jazz. Miss Erin will be taking it a step further and putting a Modern dance twist to the class. This style of dance will incorporate technical elements such as turns, jumps and partnering.

Ballet: If you need help placing your child, please talk to Ms. Gianna or Miss Hannah. Ballet 1: Students who have just left a ballet combo class and for those students who do not have previous Ballet training. Ballet 2, 3, 4: Please contact PAC-LV for any questions about placement dance.paclv@gmail.com. All ballet classes are divided by ability, not age.

Combination Classes: All combination classes will have equal amounts of time working on each style of dance. For example, one week a full hour of Ballet and the next week a full hour of Hip Hop OR a half hour of Ballet and a half hour of Hip Hop. All combination classes will perform two dances in the recital.

Contemporary/Lyrical: A form of dance through the expression of the song lyrics that combines modern dance elements and classical ballet elements.

Dance Teams: Pirouette, Jete, Fouette:: Auditions are required. The dance team is for serious and dedicated students who are looking to perform throughout the year and to compete in competitions. Students that make the dance team must take Ballet, Strengthening and Conditioning, one other form of dance and their specified time for dance team; totaling 4 classes per week. Hip-Hop 1 & 2 (Non-Competition): For those students not interested in competing with Hip Hop.

Jazz: Dance form that is matched to rhythms and techniques of jazz music.

Musical Theatre Dance: Will cover all elements of musical theatre, such as staging, Tap dance, kick lines, etc...this class is great for those students who love to sing, dance and act. Tap shoes will be required. Students will perform two dances in the recital.

Pom Dance: Dancing while using Pom Poms and is a style mainly performed by high school and college students during athletic events. This style of dance incorporates elements of jazz, hip hop, and cheerleading.

Pre-K: Ages 3 to 5. Variety of all types of dance will be taught at a beginner level: Ballet, Tap, and Creative Movement. Pre-K will perform two dances in the recital, a Ballet dance and Tap dance. One parent or guardian must remain in the lobby of the studio during class. Hannah Stahley, Owner/Director, teaches all Pre-K classes.

Strengthening & Conditioning: This class combines strength work and cardio through intervals of high and low intensity dance moves to give you the best of both worlds! A total workout, combining all elements of fitness – cardio, muscle conditioning, balance and flexibility, and boosted energy.

Tap: We will focus on Broadway style Tap as well as street Tap.

Tutu Cute: Ages 2 and 3. This class is held for 5 weeks at a time. Ballet and Creative Movement will be taught in a fun way for your little dancer. Students do not need to be potty trained. One parent or guardian must remain in the lobby of the studio during class. Hannah Stahley, Owner/Director, teaches all Tutu Cute classes.
